## **Donor Request Statement**

The mission of the Zoeza Institute is to facilitate the successful transition of at-risk youth into productive careers and independent living by using a customized, research-based educational intervention model to: 1) establish long-term, high-touch, sustainable mentor relationships; 2) incorporate "strength-based" basic education instruction; 3) improve social acumen and confidence; 4) provide vocation-specific skills through training, development and apprenticeships; and 5) provide ongoing access to a comprehensive resource portal that offers professional network and information services.

To realize these objectives, the Zoeza Institute provides services in the areas of mentoring, consulting, and knowledge management. Currently, the following programs are offered:

- The <u>Surrogate Mentoring and Responsible Transition</u> (SMART®) program is being offered in partnership with White-Williams Scholars and offers a weekly program for high academic achievers that includes one-on-one mentoring, group mentoring, cultural immersion experiences, academic tutoring, and professional apprenticeships.
- The <u>Building Exceptional Lifelong Leadership</u> (BELL) program provides students at Dunbar Elementary School, in North Philadelphia, with mentoring services targeted towards social, community, and professional leadership.

Through these programs, the Zoeza Institute is able to establish relationships with targeted youth, provide service interventions, and prepare to guide them through a transition to independent living.
